# **Policy and Influence**

Over the recent months SDDP has had several opportunities to engage with and present key issues facing dairy farmers and the industry. Critical messages have been consistent in these meeting with focus on the need for a "year around" Guest Worker bill, Trade and the impact of tariffs, and communicating the intense challenges facing producers with the ag economy.

#### Meetings and action has included:

**August:** Meeting directly with Representative and Governor candidate Kristi Noem. Chair Post emphasized messaging above, and included leadership needed in South Dakota from top down to keep our dairy industry growing.


**September:** Meeting with House of Representative candidate Dusty Johnson in conjunction with other ag associations in an informational meeting coordinated by Farm Bureau. Chair Post and Dairy Producer Randy Gross again provided information on why the issues above are so critical for SD Dairy.

**H.R. 6417**—SDDP submitted request to Representative Noem to become a co-sponsor which she acted on in July. SDDP continues to join with ADC and NMPF as they communicate directly with Legislators on the need for this bill.

SDDP is committed to opportunities regardless of Party affiliation and working on setting up other meetings with candidates and sitting officials.

Earlier this year, SDDP Chair Post participated in a Washington DC Fly in with representatives from several neighboring state trade associations. Plans are to repeat this opportunity to meet directly with lawmakers in 2019.
