SDDP provides input for Representative Dusty Johnson visit to South Dakota

On a recent visit to South Dakota, Representative Dusty Johnson was hosted by Walt Bones and a number of farmers to hear first hand how the severe weather impacts of this spring have the potential for tremendous negative effects to farmers. A primary reason to the dialogue was the limitations of current rules in crop insurance, and a looming disaster relative to unplanted acres and forage shortages.

SDDP was able to provide information specific to dairy farmers on possible acres and tons of feedstuffs eliminated from contributing to the feed supply needed by dairies due to the severe winter and the extreme water conditions this spring. SDDP Board member Allen Merrill was able to provide this information to Walt and the group, and together the coalition of farmers presented a clear case to Representative Johnson and Ag Policy staff member John Weber.

Potential solutions for issues like this take time to work through the legislature and various agencies, and SDDP looks for every opportunity to raise awareness of issue that desperately need the attention of our national and state officials.
