While some of the activities do not provide immediate solutions, SDDP continues to be a main point of contact, along with it's individual farmers for state and federal government agencies...and they do hear our voice. Below summarized some of the opportunities SDDP has taken advantage of to communicate our dairy industry needs.

Washington DC fly in: 23 meetings in 2 days with Marv Post and Tom Peterson

~Face-to-Face meetings with South Dakota Congressional members Senator's Thune and Rounds, and House Representative Dusty Johnson.
