# Legislative Update:



HB 1153—Design and Construct a new dairy research farm at SDSU

Late Monday evening, HB 1153 successfully passed the Senate floor with a vote of 30-5 in favor of the state funding \$7.5M of the SDSU dairy research farm. On Tuesday, the amendment which took the funding from \$1 back to the original bill amount was concurred in the House and enrolled by the LRC pending signatures of the Speaker of the House, President of the Senate and eventually Governor.

Thank you to the South Dakota Dairy Industry for all of the work that went into moving this bill along. We also recognize the leadership of Representative Larry Tidemann, Senator John Wiik, and Representative Randy Gross for steering this legislation from start to finish. SDDP lobbyist Brenda Forman stepped in once the bill moved past House appropriations and did an excellent job in ensuring that all legislators had one-pagers highlighting the benefits the entire dairy industry provides South Dakota to shore up support.
