POLICY ISSUES:

SDDP Board Members Serve as Task Force Members of FMMO Milk Pricing Coalition:

SDDP Board members Marv Post, Michael Crinion and Allen Merrill continue to serve on the FMMO task force comprised of representation from MN Milk, Iowa State Dairy, Nebraska State Dairy, SDDP, DBA of WI, and Edge Cooperative. This group was assembled earlier in the year when there was considerable discussion surrounding the milk pricing orders and negative impacts of PPD's. While it seems like things have quieted down around the FMMO, SDDP board members feel strongly that SDDP dairy farmers and industry members need to have a seat at the table with any topic which has a direct impact to dairy farmers and processor partners. To this point, the SDDP members of the task force are approaching as an educational opportunity to learn more about methodology and processes which go into milk pricing. A better understanding will be beneficial for all members as the subject may get more attention moving into a new Farm Bill cycle.
